## The Results of the **54th Avenue S. Corridor Study**

**Background:** In 2006, at the request of the City of St. Petersburg, a transportation study was conducted on a segment of 54<sup>th</sup> Avenue S. that runs from 28<sup>th</sup> Street to 41<sup>st</sup> Street. The study looked at the safety issues and other transportation needs of motorists, pedestrians, transit users and bicyclists. Public input was used to develop the recommendations for this study.
